Not to replace 1<sup>st</sup> responders, but how to assist people until 1<sup>st</sup> responders can cover all of an affected area</li> <li>Training is 27 hours, 3 hrs a week for 9 weeks classroom style, also can be done on-line self-directed, can be done in a weekend Sat/Sun classroom style as well. Minimum 10 maximum 30 participants per classroom course</li> <li>Suggestion made that Karl Rd. Library would be a good training location</li> </ul>
